ORDINANCE No.036,S-2022

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF REAL HYMN WORDS AND MUSIC AS A LOCALIZED ANTHEM TO BE SUNG IN ALL PUBLIC OCCASION WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF REAL, QUEZON AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF REAL, QUEZON

SECTION I. This Ordinance shall be known as "**REAL HYMN**" of Real, Quezon and shall be referred to as an Ordinance.

SECTION II. DECLARATION OF PRINCIPLE

- a. It is a preferential duty of the Local Government Unit (LGU) to enact laws for the institutionalization of a locally adapted heritage music that will be sung in all public occasion of the community.
- b. Whereas, there is an existing words and music, the "**REAL HYMN**" which defined peoples values on economy and the environment, expressed heritage of culture and arts.
- c. Whereas, this "**REAL HYMN**" the centennial words and music of Real, Quezon should become part of the growing economy of this community.

SECTION III. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- a. **Preferential Duty**- refers to any function, obligation or responsibility of any officer of a Local Government Unit (LGU).
- b. **Institutionalization**- it refers to any action of adaption and enactment in to laws.
- c. **Public Occasion**- refers to any program, social or inter-social activity of gatherings of the Local Government or its instrumentalities.

SECTION IV. The Words and Music **"REAL HYMN"** is a symbolic heritage of the community that will become part of the life of every Realeño.

SECTION V. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. For further implementation, the Local Chief Executive (LCE) should issue and Executive Order (E.O) to promulgate the guidelines to every government offices and instrumentalities to sing the "Real Hymn" in their inter-social activities or gatherings.
2. Other Government offices like, Department of Education (DepEd) thru their School Heads and other office counterpart shall comply for the use and sing of this hymn during their morning devotion to recognize the essence of this localized anthem.
3. And all Barangay Government of the territorial jurisdiction of Real, Quezon shall help to promote the use and sing of this Hymn in their every Flag Ceremony Program.

SECTION VI. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgment or action shall not affect or impair the other sections or provisions thereof.

SECTION VII. REPEALING CLAUSE – All Ordinances, resolutions, orders or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION VIII. EFFECTIVITY– This Ordinance shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force unless otherwise superseded or amended by competent authority.




