**RESOLUTION NO. 309, S- 2021**

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING, ADOPTING AND ENDORSING THE GREEN ROUTES ECONOMIC ENGINE IN THE NEW NORMAL (GREEN CORRIDOR) INITIATIVE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM (DOT) THAT HIGHLIGHTS THE RESILIENT, PROSPEROUS FUTURE FOR TOURISM ATTRACTION, DESTINATIONS AND ITS PEOPLE.

**WHEREAS**, presented for consideration of this august Body is an urgent request dated June 9, 2021 from Hon. Diana Abigail D. Aquino to adopt measures in order to maintain, protect and sustainability develop the "Green Corridor" and its tourist destinations;

**WHEREAS**, Tourism is one of the sectors hardest-hit by the COVID-19 pandemic, especially in countries where it is a crucial economic pillar. Digital technologies play a valuable role in helping countries like the Philippines bounce back and restart tourism activities in the new normal;

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine tourism department has embarked on a digital tourism campaign to promote its tourism attractions and encourage foreign visitors arrival once pandemic related travel restrictions are lifted. They are also enforcing tourism establishment to adopt strict health safety protocols by encouraging contactless and cashless transactions;

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 Article II of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall protect and advance the rights of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Tourism of Quezon with the guidance of the Department of Tourism Region 4A has created a tourism cluster destination consisting of three (3) contiguous local government units, namely Real, Infanta and General Nakar to jumpstart the tourism industry in the 1<sup>st</sup> District of Quezon, also known as the Green Corridor in compliance with the tourism recovery program of the DOT while bearing in mind with the protocols and guidelines of the new normal;

**WHEREAS**, in order to preserve tourist destinations in the Municipality of Real, the barangays within the cluster adopt measures pursuant to this resolution in compliance with the mandate of the DOT R4A, in order to maintain and protect the natural beauty and culture of the Municipality of Real;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion of PPSK Jenra D. Asis and unanimously seconded;

**RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to urge all barangays of this municipality within the cluster tourist destinations to adopt measures in order to maintain, protect and sustainably develop the "Green Corridor" and its tourist destinations;

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, to furnish copies of this resolution to Provincial Tourism Office and to all barangays of this municipality for their information and appropriate action.


